C. meeting: Application for a COA, Amy Vochazter, Terra Firma Property Solutions, LLC is seeking permission to rehabilitate the façade of the property at 305 N. 13th St., a contributing structure in the Museum Hill Local Historic District. The proposed project includes;
  - i. Remove faux brick asphalt cladding from beneath the gable and the dormers to determine what is underneath, and determine if it is able to be saved by repairs and painting. If unable to be saved, it is requested that it be replaced with SmartSide® shake siding.
  - ii. Rebuild upper porch deck; and
  - iii. The frieze above the porch will be constructed with two 2" x 10" and one 2" x 6"boards to look like the original box; and
  - iv. Four 8" or 10" round wood, vinyl, or fiberglass columns will be added where the original large round columns were; and
  - v. Replace all existing windows with vinyl replacement insert sashes, all original outer wood sills and trim will remain; and
  - vi. Concrete front porch slab will be replaced with a wood decking with the railings and spindles matching the photo, they will have to be taller to meet existing code.
