ITEM #1 Call to Order.

Chairman Sheila Murray called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

ITEM #2 Approval of minutes

Chair Murray brought up concerns with recent vehicle break ins in Stonecrest. Chief Connally explained steps the police department has taken to address the issue. Dennis Adams suggested a PSA to educate concealed carry citizens on what to do when stopped by the police. With summertime coming up and the associated increase in juvenile crime, Charles Davis suggested a PSA to encourage involved parenting and community involvement.

ITEM #4 Interaction with Police Department

Chief Connally discussed the projects the department has undertaken to address community issues. These include helicopter operations, reckless motorcycle rider operations, shoplifting operations at the north shoppes area, and at the request of the schools our K-9s conducted operations at all of the middle schools.

Chief Connally also discussed our community outreach programs. These included the reading adventure programs in which officers read to children at area schools, the Citizens Academy, 911 for

kids, Safety Town, a neighborhood cleanup (participated in by Chief Connally and Cmdr Wilson) around the crossing.

Chief Connally then informed the committee of upcoming department sponsored or department involved community events. These include The Bigs in Blue function on 06/08/19 sponsored by BBBS, The SJPD teen academy starting July 15th, the SJPD Cops who Care kids Camp starting July 29th, and National Night Out on August 6th.

Chief Connally also presented the annual Traffic Stop reporting summary to the committee. Chief Connally concluded with a presentation on this quarter's crime stats.
