Certificate of Appropriateness - A request for approval of a Certificate of Appropriateness for installation of a commercial chain link fence with privacy slats on the north side of the building located at 222 S 4th Street, as requested by Tom Morton and Sarah York.

Sarah York-1152 Riverside Trace, Sugar Hill, GA-spoke on behalf of the item. York stated she wanted to install a privacy fence on the north side of the building. York stated she and her partner, Tom Morton were looking forward to restoring the building.

Dillon asked if the fence was to separate their property from the neighboring gas station

York responded to provide more privacy and some protection

Hamilton asked if there was to be a carport on the property as indicated on the drawing
