Call to Order.

John Reese called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Item 1 - Approve May 11, 2022 meeting minutes. Robert motioned to approve the May 11, 2022 meeting minutes and Keith Marriot seconded the motion. By general consent, the minutes from the May 11, 2022 meeting were unanimously approved. **Motion Carried.**

Item 2 - Discuss formal request received from Herzog Contracting Corp., requesting to rename Messanie Street from Riverside Road to 50th Street to "Herzog Drive". Herzog or one of its subsidiaries now owns most of the property on both the north and south sides of Messanie Street in this area. This item was discussed with no negative comments or oppositions from surrounding property owners or Board Members and the final consensus was to approve. Mike Voltz motioned to approve the request to rename Messanie Street and move on to Council and Keith Marriot seconded. By general consent, the motion was unanimously approved. **Motion Carried.**

Item 3 - Discuss formal request received from Jason Beeman, requesting parking be restored outside of Moss Castle (old Barbosa's Restaurant) on the southside of Sylvania Street, between 9th and 10th Street. The commercial building is being converted back into a residential home and this request will restore parking access to the original main entrance of the home. The original request to remove parking was passed by Traffic Commission many years ago when the building became a commercial establishment. Now it is being restored back to residential and the owners are requesting parking be restored to the original main entrance. This item was discussed with no negative comments or oppositions and the consensus was to approve. Robert Douglass motioned to reestablish parking and send to Council for final approval and Mike Voltz seconded the motion. By general consent, the motion was unanimously approved. **Motion Carried.**

Robert Douglass motioned that the meeting be adjourned and Keith Marriot seconded. **Meeting Adjourned.**
