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**OPENING REPORTS**-Chairman Bob Dempster called the meeting to order.

**Roll Call.** A quorum was present.

Bruce Woody motioned that the May 9, 2019 minutes were approved, seconded by Madison Davis, motion approved.

Chance Long informed the board that the TAP grant Ordinance to construct a new trail, was going back to council June 3, 2019. We will be accepting the agreement. This is the trail segment from Cook to Blackwell.

The TIP update is ready for final board approval Madison Davis motioned to approve the TIP update; Bruce Lundy seconded the motion. Motion approved. This was a full update and will go into effect July 1, 2019. The TIP will be program years 2020-2023. Then this will go to the Governor to be signed, there were no public comments.

The Emergency amendment shoulder prevention and maintenance to I-29 , the amendment was approved as an E-Vote . This is the current 2019-2022 TIP, the current TIP is set to expire July 1<sup>st</sup>.

The MPO applied for the Blueprint grant to have a changeable message board, after the floods and needing to deploy all the signs this will be a good addition to have. The Blueprint grant does not have a match.

The MTP project update. This had 262 survey response's, AECOM will have a final update towards the end of the month, before the July 11<sup>th</sup> meeting. Aecom has subcontracted with HG consulting. The top 30 scoring projects will be assigned a cost estimate, with the St. Joseph bridges already having a cost association that will be included. This will establish the tier I and tier II projects.

Abe Forney, manager of the St. Joseph Airport, gave a power point presentation updating the board on current Airport projects. The Airport Master plan was finally approved. The Airport continues to work closely with the 189<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing.

Next meeting: Joint meeting will be July 11, 2019 Fourth Floor conference Room 12:00. AECOM will be in town to present the 2045 MTP. An open house will be that evening for public comment period to start.

### **OPENING REPORTS**

Roll Call of Voting Members. A quorum was present. Chair Brady McKinley called the meeting to order. Brady welcomed everyone and thanked them for attending.

Approval of minutes. Abe Forney motioned to approve the minutes from the last meeting and Mike Henderson seconded. Minutes from the Technical Committee Meeting on March 14, 2019 were **unanimously approved.**

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Trail Update: The TAP Grant agreement for the next phase of trails did not make it through Council. It will be resubmitted in the near future and is expected to pass.

TIP Update: The complete TIP update was provided with all comments that were received. No major changes were made since it was first presented. After approval by the Technical Committee, it will go out for public comment for a week, and then to the Coordinating Committee for official approval. It should in place by July 1. Shannon Kusilek motioned to accept the TIP amendment and Andy Clements seconded. The TIP amendment was **unanimously approved.**

TIP Emergency Amendment: This amendment was passed by e-vote and went out for public comment. This MoDOT project was to seal the rumble stripes and shoulder work on I-29. No action needed.

Blueprint Grant: Blueprint grant proposed projects and summary sheet were presented to the committee for subjective point grading. The grant funding of approximately \$50,000 is given for activities promoting roadway safety in our area.

MTP Project and Metro Quest Update: 262 people completed the Metro Quest survey. The top 30 projects will be assigned a dollar amount.

Project Information: MoDOT update. Shannon Kusilek presented some ideas that could be possible if additional funding was available. Several repaving needs and bridge work were discussed as possible backfilling. Chance will email the list of projects for members to rank their top projects.

Bike to Work Day: The 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Bike to Work Day will be on Friday, May 17th. 28 people have registered for the event.
